TVEC Students Visit VA Hospital in Coatesville

Elverson, PA – Student representative of the Twin Valley Elementary Center (TVEC) recently gave up their day off to distribute poppies to veterans at the Veteran’s Hospital in Coatesville. Students in the Bottom Red Neighborhood of the Center created poppies made out of foam, tissue paper and pipe cleaners to thank the veterans for their service in past wars.

The poppy distribution is part of a service theme throughout the school in conjunction with the Reading Is Fundamental (RIF) program as the principal and staff would like TVEC students to learn to give back to the community. Other neighborhoods in the building are conducting service projects including raising funds for the new Twin Valley Fire Company building.

There are six classrooms in the Bottom Red Neighborhood – Mrs. Gaul, Kindergarten; Mrs. King and Mrs. Dunleavy, 1-2 Multiage; Mrs. Oberholtzer, Grade 3; and Miss Ahn and Mrs. Sanger, 3-4 Multiage.

“The students made the poppies and the notes,” said Mrs. Margaret Dombach, TVEC librarian and the overall organizer of the RIF program. “Since the Coatesville Veteran’s Hospital was so close to our community, we decided to deliver them there.”

In addition to the work of the staff, the TVEC Partners in Education (PIE) provided funding for the program.
